







Getting your students started

1 Log in options

- A. Students can create an account by going to our website (mathspace.co), tapping 'Join a class' and entering the class code that you give them.
- B. You can also manually add students from the teacher dashboard, then share the login details with them.
- C. Mathspace also offers Single Sign On (SSO). Check with your Mathspace account manager to see if our SSO options apply to your school.

2 Exploring Mathspace

Assign your students a small task and encourage them to get familiar with Mathspace. Some great features to tell them about include:

-  They can get hints as they work through each step of a question. They won't be penalized for asking for hints.
-  Students can watch video lessons made by our very own Mathspace teachers.
-  A hollow check means that your student's calculations are on the right track, and they should keep going to solve the question.
-  Students can use the math toolbar to insert mathematical symbols as they work.
-  After using the hints, students can select "skip step". They'll lose some points, but it will help them to get back on track when they're stuck.
-  Students can revise all the topics they're studying at school using our digital textbook, called the eBook.
